Update from Supervisor Rowe's Representative Elaine Villareal

- 1. A few months ago, Supervisor Rowe spearheaded the effort to pass a resolution that strongly opposes the release of out of county sexually violent predators in San Bernardino County. Over the last couple of years other counties tried to place sexually violent predators in our rural desert communities and this made a strong statement that San Bernardino is not a dumping ground. The Board of Supervisors unanimously approved Supervisor Rowe's proposed resolution so we can protect our communities.
- 2. Supervisor Rowe provided \$68,985 to the Newberry Springs Fire Department for their electrical systems upgrade project. This funding will support the fire department's operations so they can continue focusing on providing the best possible services to the community.
- 3. Last month the Board of Supervisors approved 2 projects at Calico Ghost Town. The first project will replace the pedestrian bridge with a new and improved one. The second project will repair the Silver Bowl Stage which has severe structural damage after the storm.
