Helendale CSD, Helendale Senior Outreach and Barstow Community Hospital are working together to bring FREE quarterly doctor talks to the community.

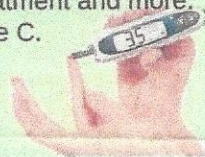

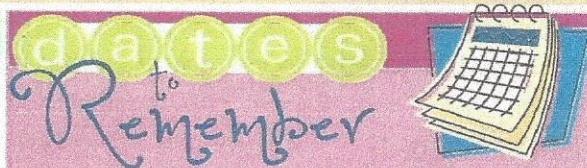
